Dear Stephen,

Please find enclosed two letters I have sent on to David Duffy CEO of the CYGB Group of Companies and Tuesday of this week a letter to Nicky Morgan who as you know chairs The All Party Treasury Select Committee in the House of Commons .This last letter has been copied to John Glen First Secretary to HM Treasury and to Andrew Bailey CEO of the Financial Conduct Authority. As explained I intend to commence a hunger strike on the 17<sup>th</sup> of March this Sunday in Glasgow in protest at the treatment by Clydesdale Bank as it was known as ( now CYGB Group ) and the Cerberus /Promontoria Group of Companies who have been entrusted by Clydesdale Bank to liquidate my loans and to acquire the benefits of my PG that I gave to this bank.

I am appealing to your organization as the representative trade body to intercede on my behalf . I believe that the Clydesdale Bank and Cerberus /Promontoria have used a dubious legal sale of my loans to Cerberus , redacted by as much as 70% in one document and the other I have not seen at all. The result of this sale of my loans has been the this dreadful treatment of myself and my family which has seen me being involved in 8 court cases in 36 months. Indeed on Friday morning the 15<sup>th</sup> of March I appear for myself as a litigant in person in two actions which include both Clydesdale Bank ( CYGB) and Cerberus/ Promontoria ( Chestnut) Ltd.

Can this be fair can this be justice? In my desperation I ask you to take an active interest in my plight and that of many many others who have fallen victim to a banking scandal that has no justification or sense. I hope you might achieve some help failing which my hunger strike will take me into a very dark place the implications which for me I am not sure what that might be and my family and friends who are besides themselves with worry.
